- B. Call from Marion VandenHeuvel at 205 Main Street concerned with cars not obeying the Village speed limit of 40MPH. She would like to see a Police presence and change the speed limit. Mayor Caza did speak with Officer in Charge (OIC) Brian Rossi and he has been using radar in that area and will continue to patrol that portion of the road. According to OIC Rossi, the highest speed detected was 47MPH. Clerk/Treasurer Leslie Price will contact Rob Pacette with NYS DOT with regards to crosswalks, signage, and speed.

**Outgoing Correspondence:**

- A. Letter to Mr. Goldswor, President of Schoharie County Chamber regarding the May and June rent was read to the Board and was mailed on 5/19/2020.

**Old Business -**
